# **GENERAL POSITION SUMMARY:**

The Senior MSD Officer will oversee the technical delivery of the STREAM programme using MSD approach at all stages of the programme. This role requires h/she to apply a wide variety of market systems development tools and models in order to catalyse innovatively inclusive services and facilitate linkages between market actors. S/he will lead the development and administration of Standard Operating Procedures (SOP), the designing and implementation of high-quality MSD interventions (Programme Quality), and building relationships and partnership with key market actors (partnership management). The Senior MSD Officer will work closely with the STREAM Programme Manager and the MEL Specialist to develop robust Monitoring and Results Measurement (MRM) and learning system for the STREAM programme (Learning and impact). S/he is a member of the STREAM Programme Management Team (PMT) which is responsible for defining, implementing and achieving the programme strategy. This role requires accountability of the programmes to the programme participants, donors, stakeholders through timely reporting, feedbacks, etc. It also requires excellent skills and experience in designing and implementing programmes using Market in Crisis (MiC) framework. Mercy Corps South Sudan is well positioned to grow its MSD portfolio, presenting exciting potential for the position holder's leadership role to grow in influence and impact.

- Develop intervention concept notes to address constraints in the market systems based on finding of assessment.
- •Identify value-addition opportunities that strengthen economic opportunities, especially for agribusinesses as identified by local and national government as well as independent market studies and needs assessments.
- •Support in setting direction by prioritizing and organizing actions & resources to achieve objectives and contribute to programme goal.
