

Job Summary:

The Project Officer will be responsible for the overall coordination and implementation of the LIFTUP Project aimed at improving HIV outcomes for children under 15 in South Sudan. This position requires strong leadership, community engagement, and the ability to collaborate with multiple stakeholders to achieve project objectives.

Key Responsibilities:

- Oversee project implementation, ensuring activities are carried out in alignment with project objectives, timelines, and budget.
- Coordinate stakeholder meetings, including inception meetings with local leaders, health officials, and partner organizations.
- Supervise the training and deployment of Community Outreach Workers and their Supervisors across the four targeted locations.
- Monitor weekly community engagement sessions, ensuring the proper use of Social Behavior Change Communication (SBCC) tools.
- Coordinate the development and broadcasting of radio public service announcements (PSAs) and radio talk shows.
- · Conduct regular field visits to ensure activities are being implemented effectively, offering guidance to outreach teams.





- Prepare monthly and quarterly progress reports for submission to the Program Manager.
- Work closely with stakeholders, including local government, health partners, media outlets, and community leaders to ensure successful implementation and sustainability of the project.
- Ensure compliance with donor guidelines and organizational policies.

Minimum qualifications:

- Diploma in Public Health, Clinical medicine, Development Studies, Social Work, or a related field.
- Minimum of 3-5 years of experience in project management, particularly in HIV/AIDS programming.
- Experience in working with local communities and managing teams.
- Strong understanding of South Sudan's healthcare landscape and the HIV/AIDS context.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- · Proficiency in MS Office (Word, Excel, PowerPoint).
