# Purpose of the position:

The purpose of this position is to provide leadership in CMAM/MIYCN interventions in Gogrial East Emergency nutrition project. The Nutrition officer will work closely with all facility base Staff to ensure that MIYCN/CMAM activities are well integrated into the Health Care system. The officer will be accountable for delivery of quality MIYCN education and supporting the community groups and facility base staff to deliver the same. The position will ensure MIYCN outputs and outcomes are delivered as per project documents, the Nutrition Officer is responsible for the daily technical implementation, supervision, monitoring and reporting of the field activities and ensuring proper coordination with beneficiaries.

### **ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Take lead the implementation of MIYCN programmes that will address underlying causes of malnutrition among children, caregivers and the larger community.
- In collaboration with the Head of Project, the Nutrition/FSL Officer will assess current IYCF, nutrition, and care practices amongst the targeted communities and identifying essential practices and barriers to optimal practice that need to be addressed.
- Help design and deliver dynamic behavior change sessions with community members, particularly parents
  of infants and young children, on nutrition, hygiene, and care practices at the community level.
- Apply a holistic approach to addressing the problem of malnutrition in the community by ensuring integrating of MIYCN with Health, WASH. Protection and Food security sector.
- Work in close consultation with Food security and Livelihood sector to support Nutrition gardening
  activities with Mother support groups and caregivers of discharged children Organize and take lead
  facilitating Cooking demonstrations in the community as part of education campaigns to promote good
  Nutrition.
- Facilitate and support formation of Mother to Mother support groups and male champion groups in consultation with community leaders. Capacity building in MIYCN counselling for Health Staff, Community

Volunteers, Mother support groups and male champions.

 Participate in other FSL, nutrition, and health promotion activities that could be identified based on beneficiaries' needs ad linked with the nutrition context.

# Qualifications/Education/Knowledge/Technical Skills and Experience.

The following may be acquired through a combination of formal or self-education, prior experience or on-the-job training:

## Minimum Qualification required:

- BSc/Diploma in Health, Nutrition, Nursing or related field with a minimum of one-year relevant experience for BSc holder and two years related experience for Diploma holder
- Excellent understanding of the dynamics of conflict resolution in the context of war and extensive knowledge of South Sudan.
- Understanding of community management of acute malnutrition
- Computer skills knowledge and applications especially MS Word and Excel
- Experience in planning and organizing activities in a variety of locations
- Proven capacity to supervise, train and coach local staff and community workers.
- Experience of providing hands on service training.
- Strong organizational, interpersonal, and representational and communications skills are essential, and a team-oriented work style is a necessity.
- Excellent communication skills and a willingness to be respectful, kind, sensitive and empathies with children and their careers.
- Knowledge of humanitarian principles preferred.
- Must demonstrate patience, tolerance, problem solving, open-mindedness and interest in social justice.
- Works independently with minimum supervision. Promote gender equality within the humanitarian and development work.
- Attend meetings and training as needed.
- Understanding of the local language is mandatory.
