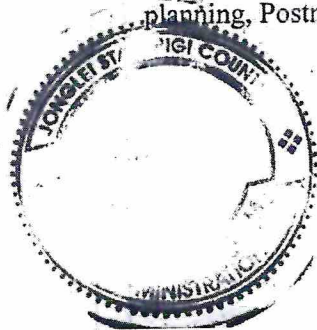

Organizational Background

International Medical Corps is a global, humanitarian, nonprofit organization dedicated to saving lives and relieving suffering through health care training and relief and development programs. Established in 1984 by volunteer doctors and nurses, International Medical Corps is a private, voluntary, nonpolitical, nonsectarian organization. Its mission is to improve the quality of life through health interventions and related activities that build local capacity in underserved communities worldwide. By offering training and health care to local populations and medical assistance to people at highest risk, and with the flexibility to respond rapidly to emergency situations, International Medical Corps rehabilitates devastated health care systems and helps bring them back to self-reliance.

ESSENTIAL JOB DUTIES / SCOPE OF WORK:

- Provide health education at the ANC, safe delivery, breastfeeding, infant care, family planning, Postnatal Care and hygiene procedures.



- Providing full antenatal care, including history taking and physical examination, identify mothers at risk and take appropriate action.
- Maintain antenatal investigation are routinely done and record all results.
- Ensure mother received Tetanus Toxoid TT and Prescribe prophylactic drugs.
- Diagnose, monitor using labour chart- partograph, and examine women during pregnancy.
- Prepare mothers psychologically and physically for delivery and inform the mother the progress of labour.
- Prepare the mothers for labour and conduct all deliveries.
- Deliver and examine placenta and remove clots.
- Take care of the baby during / after delivery.
- Recognize pathological changes and refer complicated obstetrical emergencies to the Clinical Officer or Doctor for further management.
- Offer support and advice to mothers and caregivers following events such as miscarriage, termination, stillbirth, neonatal abnormality, and neonatal death.
- Diagnosing, monitoring, and examining women during pregnancy.
- Give good care for mothers in labour and postnatal mothers / babies.

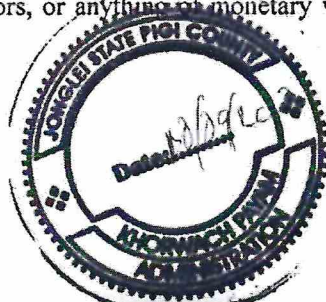
Inform the mother about immunization and ensure the first immunization is given

Prevention of Sexual Exploitation and Abuse

- Actively promote PSEA (Prevention of Sexual Exploitation and Abuse) standards within IMC and amongst, vendors-suppliers and beneficiaries served by IMC.

Compliance & Ethics: Promotes and encourages a culture of compliance and ethics throughout International Medical Corps. Competencies & Requirements

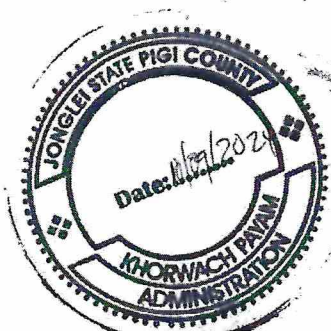
- Degree/Diploma in Midwifery, Registered Midwife from a recognized University.
- Minimum of three years of experience required, of which 1 to 2 years should be resource deprived environment.
- Previous INGO/NNGO experience.
- Have an excellent English communications skill, both oral and written.
- Demonstrated proactive approaches to problem-solving with strong decision-making capability.
- Emotional maturity and Stress management skills and time management skills.
- Highly resourceful team player, with the ability to also be extremely effective independently.
- Proven ability to handle confidential patient information with discretion, be adaptable to various competing demands, and demonstrate the highest level of customer/client service and response.
- Demonstrated ability to achieve high-performance goals and meet deadlines in a fast-paced environment.
