JOB VACANCY TRANSPORT AND CUSTOMS SUPERVISOR

Médecins Sans Frontières (MSF) is an international, humanitarian, non-governmental organization providing assistance to people in need as a result of natural and man-made disasters, irrespective of race, religion, ideology, or politics. MSF Switzerland (MSF-CH) is currently seeking to employ a qualified candidate for the following position with an initial 6-month Fixed Term Contract and Probation Period of 3 months.

Position: TRANSPORT AND CUSTOMS SUPERVISOR

Location: Juba

Scope of responsibilities:

Planning and supervising the day to day implementation of procedures and administrative processes for the efficient clearance and transportation of medical and non-medical goods in the mission according to MSF protocols, standards and procedures in order to ensure the optimal functioning of the mission

Main tasks:

Pre-clearance of Regional and International Cargoes:

- In liason with the mission pharmacist, receive and screen cargo documents for pre-clearance
- In liason with the MSF intersection customs office, pre-clear cargo throught the different government entities, I.e.
 MOFA, DFCA and NRA
- Keep End users informed of the pre-clearance status of all cargoes
- Give Greenlight to ship goods into the country after obtaining all the neccesary pre-clearance documents.

Planning and Organise for Receipt and Shipping of Regional and international cargoes and customs clearance:


- · Supervise Unloading of goods from the warehouse.
- Scrutinize all Freight Documents at reception of cargo and tally them against the physical transport reception of goods.
- Ensure all Freight Manifests are signed upon receipt and archived appropriately
- Keep all stake holders informed of an upcomming shipment to be received or shipped out
- · Liase with clearing Agent to timely clear all cargoes at the different ports of entry and exit
- Engage all the neccesary goverment organisations in relation to cargo clearances
- Ensure appropriate equipment is availed for offloading or loading specialised cargo

Planning and Organise Outbound Transportation:

- Prepare monthly and weekly transportation schedules in conjuction with the line manager, taking into consideration the priorities of operations and weather conditions especially the rainy season
- In collaboration with the other MSF sections, Explore the possibilities of consolidating shipments that are the same project direction
- Determine cargo load and define the most appropriate mode of transport with an aim of meeting the needs of projects at the lowest cost.
- Identify, manage and Monitor transporters from validated transporter list when executing MSF work
- In liason with the Biomed Manager, check condition of Reefer truck before loading medicines and physical condition of trucks before cargo is loaded.
- Supervise loading of goods from the warehouse.
- Esure all outbound shipments have the required documents prior to the their departure

Documentation, Reporting and Market Assessment:

- Esure Invoices from all service providers are obtained and setlled intime.
- Esure that all cargo documents are properly filed and archived and accesible at any time
- Produce weekly and monthly report of transport and customs activities
- Maintain a clean data base of all transport and customs activities, transporters, custom agents.
- Update the monitoring table of inbound cargo size gularly and share bi-weekly.
- Ensure complaince to New rules/Procedures relating to transport and customs and report new compliance requirments to all stake holders.





Participate in transport and customs assesments and keep in contact with Validated service providers and potential new service providers.

 Diploma in Supply Chain or Transport management or professional certification in the same field.

Desirable warehouse management-related studies.

Experience:

Essential at least 2-3 years of working experience in related activities.

• Desirable previous experience with MSF Logistics or Supply Department or other NGOs and

working experience in developing countries.

Fluent English is mandatory (Writing and Speaking) and the Local language is an asset

Computer literacy (Excel, Word & Internet) and Warehouse: (mathematics, reporting, and

analytical skills)
